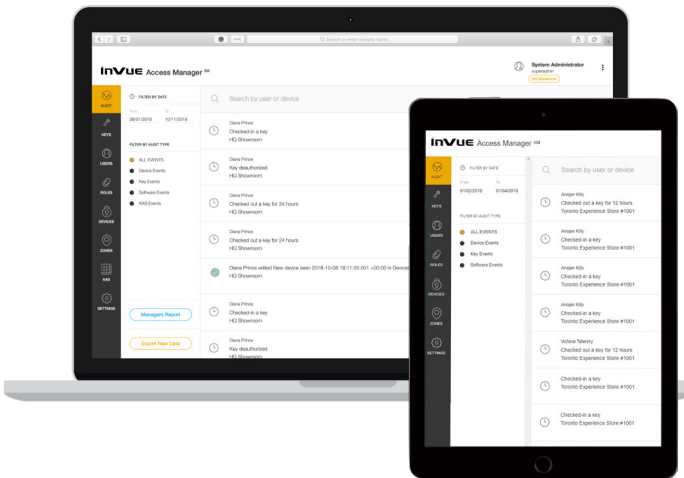


## ACCESS MANAGER

### 2 MERCHANDISING AND PRODUCT PLACEMENT

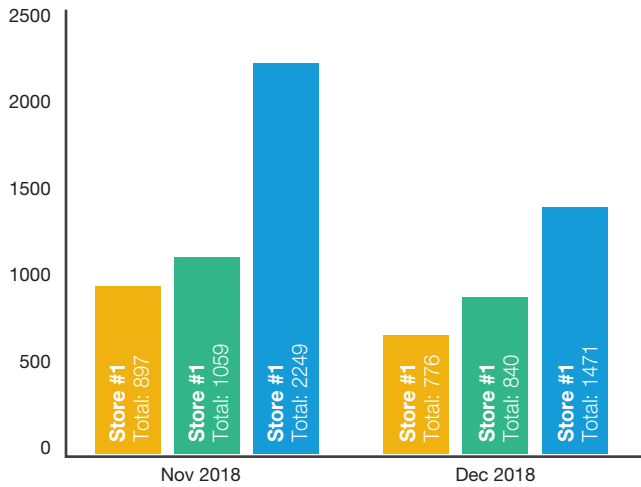
- › Are products positioned in the right locations to optimize sales?

### 3 ASSOCIATE PRODUCTIVITY

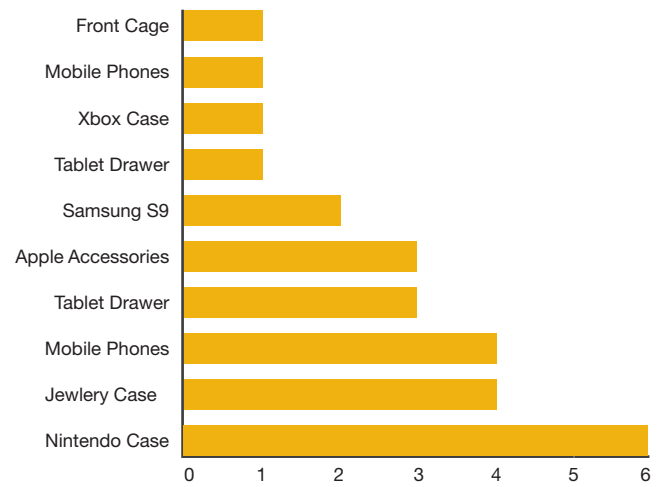
- › Who are the most productive employees?

### 1 UNAUTHORIZED ATTEMPTS



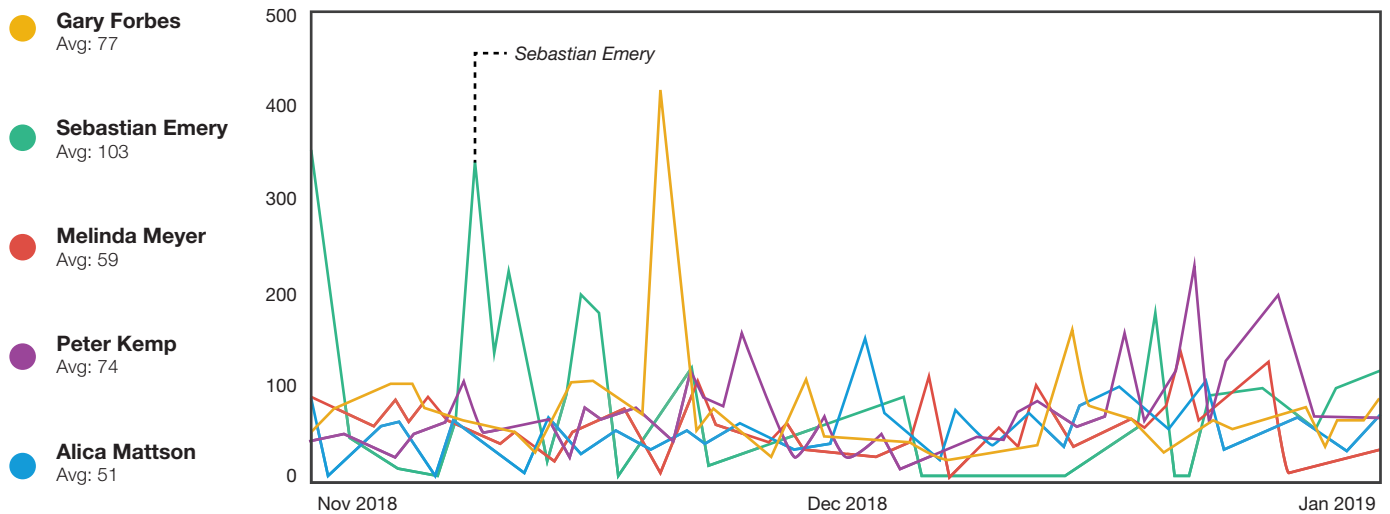
A decrease in unauthorized attempts can indicate an improvement in associate training and accountability as well as a potential decline in internal theft.

### 2 TOP 10 DEVICE INTERACTIONS



For devices with low interactions consider changes in planogram, promotional signage, or merchandising mix in order to drive greater device interaction and sales.
